VCSA-MN Chapter members collaborated with the Augsburg Park Library to offer an 8-week Free ACT Test Prep for juniors and seniors from low-income families. Given that it was the first time the library was offering this particular course, space was limited to the first 15 students that signed up. By week two of the ACT prep, there were 16 students signed up – demonstrating a need for such services in the community. An analysis of their data showed an average score of 19, up two points from the pre-test average. Over half of the students improved their scores overall. Feedback from the students' evaluations were positive and that they would recommend the course to their peers.
